



-Local medical staff took part in many of the surgical procedures, with varying degrees of responsibility depending on the case.



Complications

-Extreme bradycardia following spinal anesthesia for inguinal hernia repair, resolved with basic resuscitation maneuvers, without the need for respiratory support. Discharged without complications at 24h.

-Post-surgical stridor following total thyroidectomy, likely due to a unilateral recurrent laryngeal nerve injury, managed conservatively. Discharged at 48h without complications, with dysphonia pending follow-up.
